# Rearview Mirror

Corvair Houston drove to the George H. Bush Presidential Library on George Bush Parkway on the Texas A & M University Campus in College Station on Saturday, January 17th. Jim Watkins led the caravan and drove his white 1963 Monza coupe all of the way from Brazoria. Mark and Waynette Clarke and Waymon Worsham (Waynette's dad) came from Sugar Land in their Aggie Maroon & white 1963 Monza convertible. Jon Protteau drove his 1962 Monza convertible, 'Old Blue'. Mike and Audrey Tidwell made the trip in their '64 Monza while Jerry and Loretta Kelley and Ed Walsh traveled along in their daily drivers. The

museum's main exhibits included President Bush's life and work leading up to his presidency as well as documents, photographs, and artifacts from his time spent in the Oval Office. The museum reflected upon much of the United States history since 1941 including a World War II Avenger Torpedo Bomber, a 1947 Studebaker, a slab of the Berlin Wall, and precise replicas of President Bush's Camp David and Situation Room. In route to the Presidential Museum. Corvair Houston stopped at the Brenham Municipal Airport located at Lat/ Long:30-13-08.400N / 096-22-27.400W or 3001 Aviation Way outside Brenham for an early lunch


at the "Southern Flyer Diner" right on the airfield. This diner is open every day and has many planes flying in just to partake of their great food and atmosphere. Just outside of the restaurant entrance, was a parking area that held everything from a restored 1940 Stinson and a Beechcraft twin, and even a small jet that fired up and took off just after we arrived.

After the museum visit, the Corvair entourage stopped at an Aggie hangout called the "Hullabaloo" near Wellborn and Greens Prairie Roads, just south of College Station. The atmosphere is college rustic with plenty of rough wood, a long list of craft beers, very

good food, and friendly service. For entertainment, a parrot roosted a few feet from our table, and at first, he just stared at us without saying anything. Later, he began chattering and chuckling to himself, and finally he worked himself up to the point where he was yelling something unintelligible, possibly Aggie cheers.

Once again, club members were able to enjoy a leisurely drive on uncrowded roads with destinations that were tasty and/or educational. Please feel free to join us next time in your Corvair, or in your "water-pumper". You are welcome either way.
