



## 2017 CORSA Convention Update

Starting in February convention planning meetings will be held at 6:00 prior to the regular HACOA meetings. If you have questions don't hesitate to ask Helen or I before hand.

The search for the host hotel is over. While none of the hotels submitting proposals were perfect, the Hilton Garden Inn in Independence seems to be the best compromise. It is a little small, but there are plenty of hotels nearby for overflow. The hotel has over 300 parking spaces with plenty of public parking just across the street.

The Hereford House adjoins the hotel and will be catering the banquet.

Inside there is enough room for all indoor events and the Registration, Hospitality and Concours Tally rooms have been identified. There is plenty of room for the indoor vendors in the ballroom. Clarks will have their own room (a division of the ballroom), and the outdoor vendor area is just outside the hotel near the Hospitality Room.

There are at least three venues we can use for Wednesday's Concours judging, including Bass Pro Shop's parking lot (with a Tally Room inside), one of Independence Center's parking lots, or the parking lots in the strip mall next to the hotel.

The Precision Driving School at the Kansas City Community College, Blue Valley Campus, will let us rent their facility for the Autocross. This is the track we used for the 2011 Round Up and it is only eight minutes from the host hotel.

The Rally and EconoRun courses will be identified later. If you are familiar with the roads around Independence please offer to help with the Rally and EconoRun planning.

I sent out a preliminary list of committee chairman for the convention. If your name appeared on the list, and you do not wish to serve or would like to serve in a different capacity, please let me know. If your name was not on the list you are welcome to volunteer either as a chair or part of a committee. Mike or I will try to ask everyone on this list for his or her preferences.

The next order of business is coming up with a logo to go on the back of the 2016 Convention program. All ideas welcome. I would suggest incorporating Independence history into the logo.

This will be hard work, but thanks to the experience we've gained taking our turn hosting the Great Plains Corvair Round Ups, I think we are well prepared.





However, at the November BOD meeting it was brought up that the use of email for ballots without instructions for secrecy needed to be addressed and that a general review would be beneficial.

In order to make a review as simple and professional as possible I have appointed a By-Laws Review Committee consisting of two members with diverse demographics but legal backgrounds. Karl Cozad (Attorney) and Cindy Anders (Legal Analyst) have agreed to handle the review. That gives us a long time member (and past President) and a new member, a male and a female, a northland resident and a southland resident, a late model owner and an early model owner.

Below is a link to our By-Laws. Please read them at your convenience and at the January meeting bring any specific concerns or suggestions **in writing** and submit them to Karl or Cindy. If you are unable to attend the January meeting, then please email your concerns and suggested revisions to Karl Cozad (karl.cozad@gmail.com) and Cindy Anders (cander5@ sbcglobal.net) by January 31.

They will make the review and, according to current By-Laws, the full membership will be notified 30 days prior to a meeting where a vote on amendments would take place. Amendments require a two-thirds affirmative vote.


