How is that for a title for this article? I have some good news to report from our first "real" Board of Directors meeting as your new President. We did get a quorum of Board members. A quorum is defined as at least half of the elected Board. So seven divided by two equals three and a half. With two members still sunning themselves in Florida we still met the minimum so on with the Board Biz!

It was mentioned that we drop three or four members each month due to non-payment of dues. We thought we could improve this if we sent out a reminder in the mail to send in your dues to Clark, or show up at a future meeting and pay up. So now we will start doing that. Hopefully this will help us with membership retention.

Another item we discussed was the Swap and Sell portion of the regular meetings. It was decided that rather than have the Secretary record all of the details of what the person is selling or swapping we could have note cards made available so the items could be listed in the next Aircooler for sale. There has been a lot of chatter concerning our treasury. We seem to have an excess with a balance of a little more than \$10,000. For a Non Profit organization that is a healthy number. So what do we do with the surplus? First, we need to make sure we are operating within a budget so we don't spend down to \$0 and then wonder what happened. We will look into a budget for the year and we will entertain ideas of what do with some of the \$10k in the bank. It was suggested that we purchase a small cargo trailer to store some of the Homecoming things in. Items like the refrigerator and the gas grille need to be properly stored and should be accessible when we need them. Another idea was to look into getting better audio/ visual equipment to enhance our meeting programs. If you have any ideas or thoughts on this please let us know. Speak up at the general meeting or attend a Board Meeting as a quest and give us input!

Speaking of future Board meetings, I think trying to meet at the Elks after the regular meeting is over isn't the best way to cover Board business. So with that in mind my plan will be to combine a Board Meeting with the Second Saturday Breakfast event each month. We will move the location around to give everyone an equal chance of having a short drive time to attend. You can still come and have breakfast with us and then choose to leave once the Board BS starts. Okay?




