# 2016 ORPHAN CAR SHOW \*\*SPECIAL EVENT\*\*

The "Tucker" will be the featured automobile at the 2016 Orphan Car Show (Sunday, Sept. 18th at Riverside Park, Ypsilanti, MI.) This will be in conjunction with the Tucker National Convention that will also be taking place in Ypsilanti over Sept. 16-18, 2016...So mark your calendars. We are going to see some rare, expensive, Tuckers.

Spectator entrance is \$6.00 per person.

The Orphan Car Show is a fantastic one of a kind event that the Ypsilanti Automotive Heritage Museum puts on every fall. The show attracts unique orphan cars from all over the U.S. and Canada.

We would like to encourage more participation from our Corvair community. You must pre-register to enter in this show. Cost of entering your Corvair in the show is \$25.00 per vehicle. Deadline date to register is August 28 (you can not register the day of the show).

There are restrictions on what is allowed. For instance, you cannot bring in a modified Corvair with a V8 engine or have tricked out wheels, etc. They require original equipment and parts that would normally be on the car for that year, model, etc.

They have a special Saturday cruise to an unknown mystery destination that registered show attendees can participate in conjunction with the Orphan Car Show. I consider the Orphan Car Show one of the "must attend" car events of the year. You hear cool stories and meet very interesting people who bring vehicles that you just don't see at a regular classic In the past, Corvair attendance dominated this show with us encompassing a long double row of cars, however, our participation has been dwindling these last few years with last year's attendance having only 13 cars. Please come on out and join us. We have a great time, and the crowds absolutely love our cars. There are food vendors at this show and they're always near the Corvair section (and I know Corvair people love food). So let's show those other orphan cars that "Corvairs Rule and Others Drool" (all in fun, of course). ### MEET KERRY

My name is Kerry. I have owned Corvairs, in one form or another (and in varying degrees of condition and or repair) since I graduated from high school in Detroit Michigan in 1964. My only other hobbies, other than working under my Corvair are photography and flying rc model planes. Both are an ongoing, learning experience. I have yet to master either one.

My first Corvair was a 64 Monza 110, convertible, that I bought, with the help of my mom, in 1965. It was ember red with a black interior and top. When I first found the car, advertised in the Detroit Free Press, my older brother and I went over to check it out. The guy was pretty nice and gave us a tour and let me drive it. We told the guy that we'd (I) would like to think about it for a bit and went home. I 'thought about it' for about, oh an hour or so and called the seller back. He had gone out but I told his wife that I wanted the car, at his asking price, and would make arrangements to complete the sale. (Translation, get the money from my Mom and yes, I paid back every dime plus interest!) About three hours later the phone rang and my Mom answered it. She called upstairs to me, telling me the seller was on the phone. I took the call. fearing the worst (the car was sold, seller changed his mind about selling it, he totaled it. (Such are the thoughts that go through a teenage mind!) etc..) I said "hello" and the guy said and I quote "Hi, You know.... you are supposed to bargain with a seller when you buy a car!" I told him I wanted the car pretty bad and, since it was in good condition, it never entered my mind to 'bargain' He chuckled and said "Well next time you'll know better, I am going to knock \$300.00 off the cost of the car because I priced the car expecting that a prospective buyer would want to

negotiate a bit". \$300.00, back in 1965, was a ton of money, especially to a teen making peanuts working for a swimming pool company filling chlorine jugs all day. I never forgot that lesson nor the guy that was so kind, and HONEST with me...

That was my first Corvair and I was hooked. It was also the first in a fairly long line of Corvairs that entered my life, stayed a while and left.

The latest (and likely final) Corvair you probably already have seen, though I will include a picture with this posting. 'Baby' as my wife named her, came to us via the internet (ebay) around 2001 about a year after my Mom passed away. I have always felt that Mom had a hand at finding this car for me. It's a 1963 1/2 Monza Spyder. 99% of it looks like a 1964 though. (Hence the 1/2). The car was listed on Ebay but didn't meet the reserve price. It was located in North Carolina and my daughter and I drove down there to see (and buy) it and bring 'Baby' home to Michigan, I didn't forget the lesson learned buying my first Corvair and bargained the seller down \$500.00... I still paid too much but then again ... I wanted the car ... bad! Kerry


# ONE CORVAIR AUGUST SPECIAL EVENT


