Currently the by-laws state that you have to be a member of the parent club, CORSA in order to belong to DACC. Yes, it says that and no, we have not enforced it. Your BoD figures if CORSA isn't going to require all DACC members to belong to them then we shouldn't require CORSA membership to belong to DACC. The way the rules are written right now CORSA charges each chapter a flat \$35 annual fee.

THE FINE PRINT

At the most recent DACC Board of Directors meeting a topic was brought up that affects every member of the club; our Corporate Tax Status. Opinions were shared as to what we were required to do to maintain our tax status. One comment was that we must zero out our treasury annually. As we have never zeroed our treasury since 1974 perhaps we should look into this?

DACC is not-for-profit organization under the Federal IRS Regulations. The rules and regulations are found in the tax laws in chapter 501. We are, or at least we think we are a 501.c3 organization. That means we don't have to submit a tax return vearly to the IRS. All we do currently is make an annual report to the State of Michigan with a nominal filing fee. As long as we follow the rules set out by the Feds we should be okay. I couldn't find any reference to a requirement that we "have too much money" in the treasury or that we have to "zero it out" every year. But, I'm not a tax attorney. I'm not an anything attorney. I would like to assure the BoD and the general membership that we are doing the right thing and that we will be allowed to continue as a social club with a tax advantage.

It was decided at the Board meeting that I would work with our Treasurer (Casey) to find out what the real story is and report back to the Board. Our goal is not to change our tax status. Perhaps it is just to learn what we have and what we should do to keep it. Sounds like a good idea to me! **PETE K, PRESIDENT**


