Replacement sheet metal alternative

As many of us have learned when working on our Corvairs, especially mid western Corvairs...that reddish coating of iron oxide that eats our cars-RUST- is something we work hard to stay ahead of. In the past we have had a couple of courses of action in repair. Purchase high dollar replacement parts from out of state and hope they fit when they arrive....hunt for your part from a donor car...or, cobble your own out of sheet metal.

Now there is a very welcome LOCAL alternative. Current 2 Classic Fabrication. Touting over 80,000 pieces to fit AMC to Volkswagen ... pretty good chance they will have what you need for your 'Vaie. Body panels are made with 20 gauge coated Automotive steel. Floor pan and trunk floors are heavier 18 gauge. I have personally used their pieces....a drivers side rear floor for a '60 four door and both front floor pieces for a '65 convert. Parts are very accurate stampings and REALLY close to original. Minimal trimming to fit and a blessing to weld. Floor pan sections run about \$50 a piece. Call or check their website for more parts details. Highly recommend.

 4. Maximum length 16" long.
 5. No part of racer to hang over start gate which is 3" in height.
- It is recommended that entrants make their racers with the wheels being the widest part of the racer.

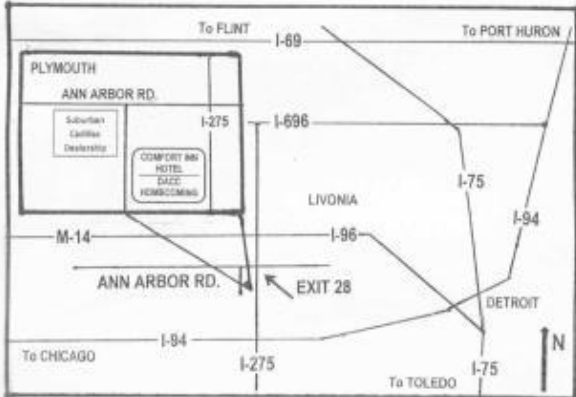
