

Since the last Treasurer's Report, we've gained a whopping 12¢ in dividends. at the end of April. We paid out \$10.00 for our annual filing with the Washington State Secretary of State as a registered non-profit organization. We also adjusted dues for two members. One sent \$2.00 as he would not be joining CORSA at the time. The \$2.00 was passed to another who had not taken the CORSA member discount. We now have \$1266.64 in Savings, \$162.13 in Checking, while our total worth is \$1428.77

Many are still behind with their dues. INCC membership is \$15.00 per year, while CORSA members pay \$13.00. Payment extends your membership one year from the current date of expiration or from the date payment is received, a very special deal for




