The Saga of the Community Corsa

This story starts out just about two years ago. I got a call from a fellow who wanted to clear out a barn in Jackson, Michigan where five Corvairs were stored by his recently deceased father. All five cars were driven up from Toledo and placed in the barn. And there they sat. Since 1972! Can you say Road Trip?

Several members of DACC converged on the location and checked out three late model coupes and two earlies. The '66 turbo Corsa went to New York. The low mileage '66 Monza was snapped up by our own Ken Hand and he had it running and driving in less than ten minutes after delivery to his place out in Fowlerville. Current Treasurer Casev Schesky bought the '64 Spyder coupe and the one-owner '64 Monza coupe eventually made it's way up to Traverse City. The fifth car of the group is the subject of this article.

The red on red '66 Corsa 140 coupe had only 60.000 miles on it when it went into the barn. The floors were solid as was the bottom of the trunk. The outside of the car didn't fare as well. Lots of bumps and creases and signs of previous attempts at bodywork. Best way to describe the passenger's side door attempt would be "Cave and Pave"! But the car had potential so it did find a buyer. New member Roger "The Painter" Shepard took it on. Roger worked on the car for many months and corrected most of the damaged areas and put the car in a fresh coat of red oxide Unfortunately due to a bump in the road of Life the car was sidelined and left parked under a car cover in his driveway. A little while later I was given the opportunity to buy the car back. Well, I bought it once, why not buy it again? So the Corsa came back to the Caveman Garage and plans were formulated to complete the project and get the car operational again. It made an

appearance at a recent DACC Tech Session up at Motor City Auto Sales so we could address the issue of a limp brake pedal. While there another member liked what he saw and bought the car from me. Cool! At the end of the day I delivered the car to John Tucker's place in Ann Arbor since Mr. Corsa was still tied down to the trailer. Ownership #2 completed!!

John finished up the brake job and replaced some hard metal lines. The gas tank had to come out to do the job properly. Now that the brake pedal actually made the brake shoes move out against the drums we had brakes! But... A sweetheart deal on a VW bus caught John's eye and he had no need for two collector car projects. The Corsa was going back on the market so what was I to do? Buy it again, of course. Ownership #3.

On the way to the storage lot still on a trailer Casey Schesky (remember him? He bought the early Spyder from the Jackson 5 collection) decided he could do a quicky paint job and flip this Corsa for some big bucks. Well, I guess reality got a hold of him and he changed his mind. So now I get to own it again. Would this be my ownership #4? In Casey's defense this was the right decision for him to let this one go. He has been toiling away on a body and paint refresh on his first-ever Corvair purchase; a 1965 Monza convertible for how many years now? I don't think quick and paint job combine in his vocabulary.

So now what do I do with this Corsa coupe that several members of the club have had a part of? We have christened it "The Community Corsa" due to the multiple member owners of the same Corvair. Right now it is in my driveway still on the trailer. I think it is looking for new owner #5. It starts and runs and



stops and goes. Or as we say up at Motor City it walks and talks. It still needs a heap of work, but it is a solid canvas for the right person. I just hope that the next time I sell this car it stays sold!!!
