Tech Article for June 2017: By Bob King

Have you looked at your 50 year old wiring harnesses lately? Getting ratty looking? There is a PM you can do to keep them going a little longer. I say a little because there is nothing you can do with 50 year old wire insulation getting brittle, strands slowly breaking, and you wonder why your lamps aren't as bright any longer. Connectors cracked, contacts distressed, corroded, or just plain greasy, I took this 65 Corsa engine harness, unwrapped it, and added the red wire in center for 12v to a future Ignitor upgrade which is needed. I also removed ALL the contacts from the connectors and wire brushed them. The clear connector at the 11:00 position is new and it got new contacts also. This is the head pressure/ temperature connector which is always bouncing around and coming loose so they need replacements. I have replaced the mini contacts in the main connector. Larry and I have a special tool we rent out for 10\$ an hour (just kidding), it is needed for some connectors to get a durable crimp. You can get one at Lowes. After a few calls including to Dave Fox our electronic tech I found what was needed. You can't use the basic solderless connector tool for everything. Rewrapped and ready to go with some replacement plastic widget holders that need to be exactly in the right place or they won't line up with the hole on the engine frame. I used Scotch supper 33 a heavier tape don't use the Harbor Freight crap unless you want to redo it again next year! So instead of vegetating in front of the tube (we don't call it that anymore I'm old, say screen) maybe grab you harness and have some fun! Happy Corvair'ing!

Total restoration with some s/s parts i.e. choke plates- accelerator pump linkage,& re-plated components. Note Carbs in picture above are modified for aftermarket air cleaners that are clamped on the top carb. Thanks to all you folks calling me!
