7. TECH TIPS OR ARTICLE

Tire pressure on a Corvair is very, very important to the handling of your Corvair. Have you tried going on the internet at CorvairForum.com?

From Bryan Blackwell's autocross website we learn the following: "... maintain a pressure differential of 8 to 10 pounds front to rear, but you can improve responsiveness and handling by raising the tire pressure up to 27 front, 35 psi rear for street use (don't exceed maximum tire inflation on the sidewall).
