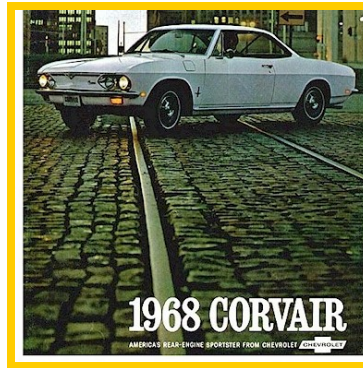


KACC is a chartered chapter of CORSA, Chapter #379

Go to <http://www.gmheritagecenter.com/gm-heritage-archive/vehicle-information-kits.html> and select the vehicle and year. Click on the year, agree to the terms, and the kit will be downloaded to your computer in a pdf format.

The restoration packets are an important and popular free service provided by Chevrolet for those customers seeking general information about their vehicle and for restoration purposes. Information included in the packets includes for most models and years: Vehicle highlights , Color Codes, Wheel/ tire specs, Complete specs on engine, transmission, suspension and other vehicle systems, Standard equipment lists, Options, Trim packages, Brake information, Suspension, Vehicle features, Exterior/interior dimensions, and Engine options.
