

The year was 1959-60 and a brand new 'revolutionary' car was about to be sold to the public.

Here are samples of advertising by one of the prominent small town dealerships of the day. I found these quite by accident while doing a bit of family genealogy and history research on another project.

Interesting to me was the fact that the gentlemen that bought the 1st Corvaire in Anniston, Ala. was stationed at Ft. McClellan. Col. AW Chapell. Not pictured is the 1st 1960 Chevrolet that was also bought by someone stationed at Ft. 'Mac', Sp5 Elida J. Morrow.

Mr. Marlon R. Mize (The Corvaire Specialist) died at the age of 81 in 2007. He was a fellow Navy Veteran and retired from Anniston Army Depot and the Chevrolet dealership.






