TREASURER'S REPORT

Since the last report we've gained \$59.00 in dues and estimated \$0.10 in dividends. We spent a total of \$218.68 in sharing the costs of meals at the Club's Christmas/Holiday Party. Now we have \$81.21 in Checking, \$1167.47 in Savings, and our total worth is \$1248.68 As mentioned several times in recent issues of the REAR ENGINE REVIEW, as we move into the New Year, we are removing from the roster, anyone who last dues paid in 2015 or earlier. As we continue on, we will drop those more than two years in arrears, by month. If you last paid in February 2016, you will be dropped after February 2018, unless you renew and pay your dues.

INCC membership is \$15.00 per year. CORSA members pay \$13.00 for INCC membership.




