How I Got involved with Corvairs - this month from Clay Grant

It was a dark, stormy, cold, rainy day in Middle GA (Just kidding about the weather) in about 1978 when My Uncle Tom Mays pulled up at the GMC Dealership he and my grandfather owned driving a 1965 Corvair 500 coupe with a 3spd. I was only 10 years old but really liked the look of this car and so, as always, he took me for a ride. The next year, he acquired a 1965 Monza 2dr coupe as well. That is when I asked why he needed 2 and the story went from there. He drove them both for several years but eventually parked them. He had also acquired a 65 Monza 4 door along the way (not sure when) which just sat in his driveway. I remember this because I had to cut the grass around it every week when I did his yard. In 1989, he towed it to the shop and started overhauling it. If it moved, he took it off, cleaned, treated, painted and/or replaced it. 2 years later he had a beautiful red Monza. Then he acquired a 1965 Corsa Convertible that I fell in love with after that.(I drove that car away from the church at my wedding.) A few years later he started on his Greenbrier which really got me excited. After it was complete he was always doing something to one of them and eventually sold the Corsa (I wanted it but could not afford it at the time). I had gotten involved in the Heart of GA Corvair club with him and was enjoying being a Corvair less member going to events including the National convention in Daytona in 2000. One Sunday after Springfest, Billy Bruce approached me and said I needed a car and he had one. Times were tough for a newlywed but Billy insisted I take the car and he brought it to me. It was his first Corvair, a 1963 Monza Convertible and I have had it ever since.(I plan on keeping it forever) Over the next 12 years, Uncle Tom and I had a lot of fun, buying, fixing up, and selling Corvairs. There is no doubt they are what kept him going until his passing in 2012 at the young age of 91. Since, I have kept going to meetings and enjoy spending time with my Corvair family.
