### Pre-meeting eating Hog Wild on 47th



Kansas City in another vehicle was Gary Jones and his son. Keith Hammett trucked in from Springfield, MO.

Shortly after their arrival Mike took charge of the differential refresh and Scott headed out to the lift to pull the PG shift cable out of the 4-door on the lift. Back inside the shop Lonene Ackerman, with some help, was decorating the lunch table with a St. Patrick's day theme.

Meanwhile Scott had the cable out of the transmission and thoroughly scrubbed with brake clean. He checked the condition of the



O ring where the cable goes into the case and deemed it reusable. Scott cut the shrink tube in half and slipped it over end of the cable to cover the joint between the metal housing and plastic cable cover. The shrink tube is Gardner Bender HWT-1138 1 1/8". It is available at Menards and some Ace Hardware Stores.

With some help from Gary and a heat gun, Scott began to shrink the tubing to fit the cable. *Continued on Pg. 5*



The tube has to shrink a lot he took his time and heated it slowly and evenly. The tube is lined with a glue/sealer that is activated with the heat and may seep out of the ends a bit. Once the tube was in place and fully shrunk, it was time to let it cool completely. This coincided with the lunch break so while the tubing chilled, everyone warmed up with a chili meal.

Installation of the cable is pretty straight forward. Place the shift lever in D(rive), then with both accelerator rods removed the the TV lever rotate it fully counter-clockwise and hold it while the end of the cable is inserted into the transmission, bolt down the retaining clip. Check for proper installation by gently rotating the TV lever counter-clockwise. If the hole in the notched arm of the lever is below the transmission pan rail, the installation is incorrect and needs to be redone.

While Scott was wrapping up the cable fix, Mike Dawson was showing the crowd inside the shop how to adjust the bearing pre-load and check the tooth engagement pattern on Mark's differential. Soon the differential refresh was completed.

Another new MCCA member, Keith Lippold, showed up with his son. Keith purchased Art Chandler's nice '61 station wagon and had me reseal the engine and some other work. It was finished so Keith was driving it back to Pratt.
