7. TECH TIPS OR ARTICLE:

Stripped Valve Cover Bolts

Page 24 Engine Mechanical
CORSA Tech Guide Supplement 1996

The bolts, which hold the valve cover to the head, are often stripped. I've had a lot of success using longer bolts, such as $\frac{1}{1}$ on $\frac{1}{4}$ long. The original was on $\frac{1}{4}$ long, and after gasket, cover, and spring clamp there is at best $\frac{1}{4}$ of thread holding the bolt in the head.

I've also drilled the middle section of the cover so I can have six bolts for the cover. This is more than adequate to seal the valve covers. (6/87)

**Club Meeting Directions - Directions to our Club meeting on May 20th at 2:30pm at the home of David and Donna Legerton, 6275 Sherman Kennedy Rd., Baker, FL:

<u>Directions to David and Donnas' Place</u> From Pensacola:

- 1. Take I10 to the Holt exit. Turn north on FL 189 towards Holt.
- 2. At the "T" (Rt 90) turn right (east) towards Crestview.
- 3. Go east for 2.75 miles on Rt 90 and turn left on the Galliver Cut Off (Rt 189).

- 4. The road will "T" onto Hwy 4 after 4.5 milesturn left (north).
- 5. Continue straight on Hwy 4 into Baker. At the light continue straight for an additional 1.5 miles and then turn left on County Road 4A.
- 6. After 0.75 miles turn right onto Jack Stokes Rd.
- 7. After 0.75 miles turn left onto Justice Johnson Rd (dirt). DO NOT make the sharp left onto McVicker Rd.
- 8. Go to the "T" (about 0.4 miles) and turn right onto Kilcrease Rd.
- 9. Go for 0.1 mile and turn left onto Sherman Kennedy Road.
- 10. We are about 0.5 miles down on the right-6275 Sherman Kennedy Rd. Look for a Blue/Cream color Pole Barn Building.

From Defuniak Springs:

- 1. Exit north from I10 at the Crestview exit. This is FL Route 85 (S. Ferdon Street).
- 2. Continue north for 2.5 miles until you reach Route 90.
- 3. Turn left (west) on Rt. 90.
- 4. Go for 4.25 miles and turn right onto FL Rt 4.

- 5. Continue straight on Hwy 4 into Baker. At the light continue straight for an additional 1.5 miles and then turn left on County Road 4A.
- 6. After 0.75 miles turn right onto Jack Stokes Rd.
- 7. After 0.75 miles turn left onto Justice Johnson Rd (dirt). DO NOT make the sharp left onto McVicker Rd.
- 8. Go to the "T" (about 0.4 miles) and turn right onto Kilcrease Rd.
- 9. Go for 0.1 mile and turn left onto Sherman Kennedy Road.
- 10. We are about 0.5 miles down on the right-6275 Sherman Kennedy Rd. Look for a Blue/Cream color Pole Barn Building.
