The car's owner, Letha Lister had approached Ron Bluhm at the museum to see if there were any Corvair mechanics in the area. Ron offered the use of his service bay and we lined up some helpers. The squad included Ian Smith, Bill Johnson, Gary Komora and myself. Letha's brother-in-law delivered the car to the museum earlier on a trailer. We pushed it inside with the help of one local guy who just happened to be walking by on his way to the tavern next door. We suckered him into helping us push. Once the car was inside we thanked him for his help and he replied that now he really did need a drink!

Our working window was only three hours, but we were determined to make this baby run! Ron made a quick repair to an ancient AC Spark Plug cleaning machine. It worked great! We had to replace the carbs and the linkage and a few other things. Fortunately I had brought along a portable Parts Department. Actually it was my 1963 Monza coupe that Ron was inspecting to see if the paint finish could be saved. We did pirate a few bits off the coupe to make the convertible sing again.

Part way through the procedure we had to stop for a Pizza break. It's okay. Mechanics get hungry, too! Letha ponied up for the eats. Yes, she was there and was helping out as well. This Corvair was a little rough, but she had a long-term ownership with it so we had to save it for her. And we were successful! Right around 3:30 we plugged in a new battery after Gary had rewired the starter

circuit. A little fiddling with the points and condenser (and a bad set of brand new points) it fired right up! Ian hopped in and tested the clutch and transmission. Viola! She moves under her own power! So you're going to ask about brakes. I heard more than once the quote "Brakes are for quitters!" and we found that the master cylinder had gone to sleep while in the shed all those years. The parking brake worked so Ian drove the car out of the shop and into the back parking lot.

Another successful Garage Squad activity. I am going to order up a new master cylinder and Letha did make a generous donation to the Garage Squad for our efforts. 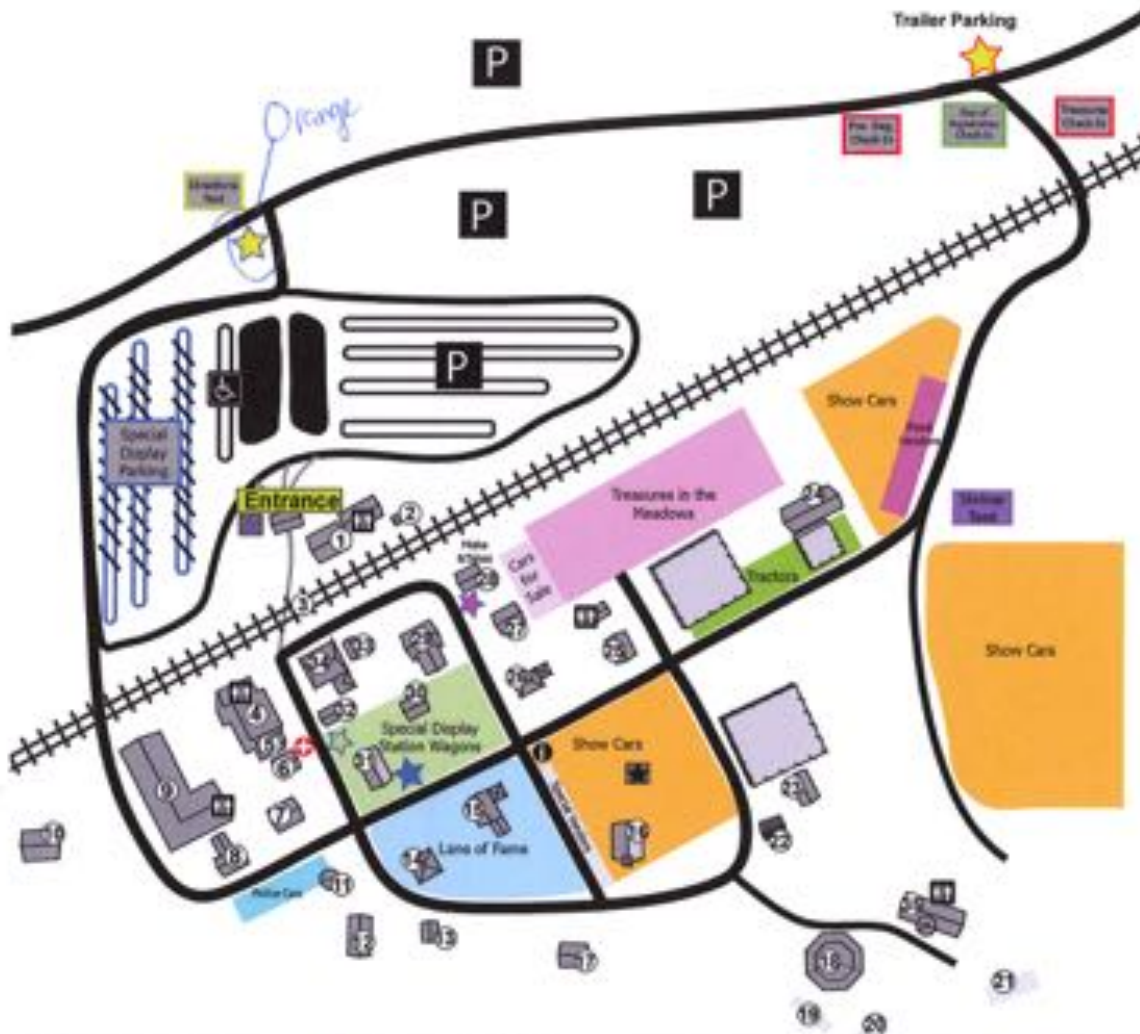

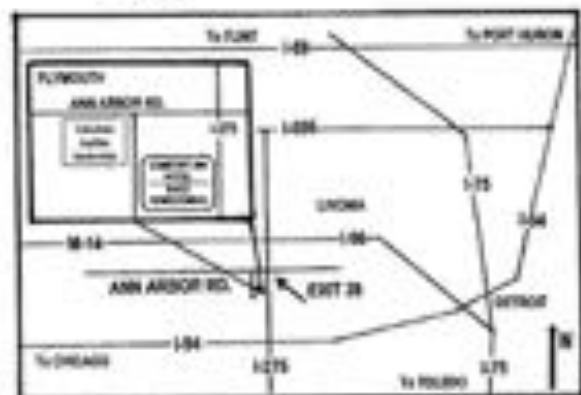
