NOTES FROM THE DECEMBER MEETING



CORVAIRS IN THE MEDIA

Our friends at Hemmings continue to feature Corvairs in their publications. The January 2019 issue of Hemmings Classic Car includes a story about automotive journalist Karl Ludvigsen and his early years working with Bill Mitchell and Zora Arkus-Duntov at GM. He ran the publicity for the design studio in the early sixties and was pictured with a silver 62 Monza Convertible and the Monza GT in the article. Ludvigsen also wrote a book titled *Corvair by Chevrolet: Experimental & Production Cars* 1957-1969.



The February edition of that same magazine ran a story about American Cars in Cuba. An early Corvair Sedan is shown in use as a taxi but the article reports that it had been converted to a front engine diesel. Replacing original American engines with wheezy diesels is apparently a common occurrence due to the embargo on American goods that still exists.
