DACC sponsors Corvair Monza SS/Chevy Jr Go Kart restoration

Last month, DACC partnered with Washtenaw Community College and student Alex Pizana for his AutoRama 2019 Monza SS/Chevy Jr. Go Kart Project.

The Monza SS was a design study and concept car built by GM Design in 1963. After this car made the show circuit, GM made a Monza SS Go Kart protoype for VP Bill Mitchell, for his son. GM then contracted with Rupp Manufacturing to build Monza SS/Chevy Jr Go Karts with the Monza SS design for markeing use. Many Chevy dealers purschased the Go Karts for display and promotional use.

Alex Pizana, Washtenaw Community College student in the Auto Body Repair and Custom Cars program, was lucky enough to have an original Monza SS/Chevy Jr Go Kart body given to him by his grandfather, who had received it back in the 70's as partial payment for some work he did.

Alex completed the restoration of the Monza SS/Chey Jr. body and it was displayed by Washtenaw Community College at AutoRama 2019 because of the high quality of the restoration. DACC member Casey Schesky assisted Alex in his efforts.

Engines, Engines Everywhere!


(NOT A ONE THAT RUNS)


