The show begins Saturday and includes technical demonstrations from professors and students, live


bands, shop tours, and much more.

The Starlight Drive-in two screen outdoor theater opened as the Rainbow Drive-in in 1953 and operated every Summer thru 2018. It is one of only five operating in Kansas and the only one in southcentral, KansasThe Theater had

been owned by Jim Goble, who died in 2015. Chuck Bucinski inherited the property and ran it as a theater until he closed it on October of 2018 citing plans to develop the land. A movement started to save the drive-in, resulting in a new owner who plans to continue to show movies.
