Cole hosted by the DACC Homecoming, "as part of the group tour at the GM Heritage Center on Friday, August 21, 2020, from 11:00am to 1:00pm. We will also have a selected 1960 Corvair on the outside podium display for photo opportunities.

David E. Cole is the eldest son of Ed Cole, former President of General Motors and considered the Father of the Corvair. David is also a fellow Inductee with his father in the Automotive Hall of Fame.
