There's something here for all age groups, but it's appeal will be a little different depending on your age. It's from 1961 and it's what would be the 4th GRAND PRIX for SPORTS CARS at Riverside International Raceway, not yet called the TIMES GRAND PRIX even though it was sponsored by the LOS ANGELES TIMES. The entry list included sport car stars of that era which included Jack Brabham, Dan Gurney, Bruce McLaren, Jim Hall, Roger Penske, Stirling Moss, Ken Miles and a host of others. But we're taking a detour from that. We're going to visit the race weekend and see the intersection of Hollywood and Chevrolet on display in a really neat way. One of the most successful TV shows ever was a western named BONANZA. It was in its 3rd season by 1961 and riding the wave, which would last until 1972. The sponsor of the show was Chevrolet. One of the stars of the show was Dan Blocker (Hoss

Cartwright was his character on the show), he was a big time race fan and ended up owning a team. He was quoted, "Auto racing is my first love, but my contract with NBC forbids me to race 'em. The next best thing is to own the cars and have someone else drive them for me." One would be the Dan Blocker/NICKEY-Chevrolet Cooper Team that was driven by Skip Hudson. These images have never been published and are a great piece of history. PHOTO 1 - You see Dan driving the 1961 Corvair Sebring Spyder Concept which would appear on the November 1961 cover of CAR and DRIVER magazine. In this photo the car has rock guards over the headlights, which didn't appear in the magazine as far as I know.
