Golden Cooler Award

This award was introduced in 2017 to recognize Chapter members who make noteworthy contributions to our Chapter. It replaces the Golden Blower award that had been retired several years earlier. The winner is chosen by our Chapter president and is usually presented at our annual holiday party in December. The winner gets to keep and display the award for one year until the next winner is chosen.

The award was hand-made and painted by Chapter president, Jim Pennell. The cooler is a rarely-seen **3-plate design** that was originally used only on 1963 Corvairs. It's mounted on a wood plaque that was hand cut and the edges routed. The Corvair model car was purchased from Wolf Enterprises, a well-known rebuilder and supplier of Corvair carburetors, located in Florida. Attached to the plaque are tags with the engraved names of each year's winner.

Member Spotlight

Tom & Linda Le May. 1966 Corsa 140 4-speed



Tom & Linda joined the Chapter in December 2018. Tom's dad worked for Chevrolet and during Tom's childhood the family owned 8 Corvairs. This is Tom's third. He bought it in North Hollywood in 1988 from the second owner. After some essential repairs, Tom drove it for about ten years. After that, it sat until early 2020 when he took it to Paolo Galli in Atascadero to bring it back to life. Paolo rebuilt the heads, carbs, brakes and did other repairs as needed. The Corvair is now back on the road and looks and drives great.

Highlights:

Built at the Van Nuys plant in Los Angeles, 3rd week of February 1966.

Still has original Protect-O-Plate.

Original interior in great condition.

Original engine bottom end.

Carburetors, brakes and original heads all rebuilt (by Paolo).

Dual master brake cylinder conversion (by Paolo).

Repainted by previous owner in original color, Ermine White (code C).

PREVAL Portable Spray Gun, model #267

This product is not new, but I just learned about it so it's new to me. The box copy describes it as "THE PROFESSIONAL PORTABLE SPRAYER". It consists of a 2oz aerosol can of some unknown compressed non-CFC gas that attaches to the top of a glass bottle. It can be used to spray paint or other liquids. Simply thin & mix the liquid, fill the bottle, attach the aerosol can and spray away. Perfect for small jobs. Easy clean up too. It's available at hardware and home supply stores for less than \$10. Thanks to Jim Pennell for showing me this neat tool.
