Main Bearing Oil Gallery Modifications

Rebuilding and overhauling Corvair engines over the years, I have noticed a problem that I do not believe has been previously addressed. The main bearing galleries cast into each engine block half do not always align with each other,, or transition properly to the bearing oil hole.


I have developed the following procedure to correct this situation. The tools required are:


* Half Main Bearing Shell

* Dill with 7/32" bit

* I/8" Ball End Mill

After separating the crankcase, remove cam, crank, and bearings. Retain one main bearing insert. Mate the engine halves, and note the alignment, or misalignment of bearing Galleries. If misalignment is noted, it should be corrected at this point. You could use the Ball End Mill, or a Dremel type tool, with abrasive cutoff type disk. See pictures below.

The "2006" Car Show season was GREAT! We had only attended twenty-one of them this year. We had a slower year because of our "New" Church




I Can Goya Red Beans in Water (no Sauce!)

Frank' Chili

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 Large Onions
- 2 Cloves of Garlic
- I Can Goya Light Red Beans in Water (no Sauce!)
- I Can Goya Black Beans in Water (no Sauce!)
- I 28 oz can Crushed Tomatoes
- I tsp. Chili Powder
- ½ tsp. Garlic Powder
- ½ tsp. Oregano
- 2 Green Peppers
- I Yellow Pepper
- 5-6 Shakes of Nutmeg
- 5 Cracks of Course Pepper



½ tsp. Crushed Red Peppers

½ tsp. Onion Powder

- 2 Red Peppers
- I Orange Pepper
- 1 12 oz jar of Fire Roasted Peppers (mild, medium, or hot)
- 5 Cracks of Salt

Prep: Dice vegetables and put in bowl. Then, cut onions and Garlic fine.

- 1. In a large pot add oil and cook onions, celery, and garlic on medium-high heat. Cook until onions are translucent and stirring frequently so garlic does not burn.
- 2. Cook Lamb in skillet until brown. Drain off grease. Add Lamb to pot. Add I tsp of chili powder, I/2 tsp crushed peppers ,garlic power, onion power and oregano. (Delete oregano if you use beef.) Add Five cracks of salt &pepper each.
- 3. Simmer on medium heat for 15 minutes.
- 4. Add all canned goods. (Be sure to drain all cans of beans and jar of red peppers). Add all peppers (coarsely diced) including roasted peppers. Add 1/2 tsp crushed peppers, and nutmeg. Salt & pepper to taste.
- Simmer 30-40 minutes, stirring occasionally.
