# INCC ANNUAL PLANNING MEETING

On Sunday February 20 at 1:00 pm, members of the Inland Northwest Corvair Club met at Frankie Doodle's to come up with an event schedule for the upcoming year. Present were: Craig Nicol, Tom Schager, Roger Becker, John Vujovich, and Dave McChesney. Also joining was John Bragg, who is associated with Columbia Basin Corvairs.

Once everyone had a bite to eat, we got down to business and came up with at least a few events to fill up the coming year. Events are listed elsewhere in this issue. In addition, as each event draws near, more detailed information will be provided.

#### "ON THE ROAD AGAIN"

The Inland Northwest Car Club Council's premiere event returned this year and took place on the evening of Saturday, February 26<sup>th</sup>. While in recent years the event had been held at the Mirabeau Hotel in Spokane Valley, this year's celebration took place in downtown Spokane at the Double Tree by Hilton near the Convention Center. Besides the change in location, the other big change is that dinners were served rather than folks serving themselves at buffet tables. That may have been because that is how that

particular establishment does things, or it may have been to lessen any risk of exposure to Covid 19. The Double Tree-Hilton staff was very efficient and all 200 or so attendees were served in a timely fashion.

During dinner and for some time thereafter, Sharkey and the Fins entertained the crowd with renditions of popular rock and rockabilly tunes from the 50s and 60s. (This band also performs throughout the Inland Northwest as Stage Coast West.)

Part of the evening's program included presentation of various awards... Newsletter of the Year, Business of the Year, Man of the Year, Woman of the Year, and Couple of the Year. Your reporter did not get a list of those receiving the awards but no doubt they will be included in the next issue of the INCCC's newsletter... which will be forwarded to all INCC members.

As is usual at these events, there were a number of raffle baskets available, a 50/50 cash drawing, and this year for the first time, several silent auction items. As he has done in the past, Dave McChesney donated copies of his (now three) books and framed prints of the cover art for the same. These were listed as being from the Inland Northwest Corvair Club. 


#### FOR SALE!


