1962 Chevrolet Corvair Monza GT

A concept car designed in part by Larry Shinoda of Corvette fame, the 1962 Chevrolet Corvair Monza GT is based on early model Corvairs. The Monza GT's engine is mounted ahead of the transaxle to create a mid-engine layout. The doors are actually part of a forward-hinged canopy; the rear-hinged bodywork opens to reveal the engine.

Although never intended to be a production vehicle, the Monza GT was a major influence on the 1964 Pontiac Banshee prototype, the 1965 Mako Shark II concept and eventually the 1968–1982 Chevrolet Corvette. Take a gander at that louvered window, fastback rear design and deeply sculpted rear



1963 Chevrolet Corvair Monza SS

A successor to the 1962 Corvair Monza GT, the 1963 Monza SS is a convertible with standard doors and an engine mounted behind the transaxle, which allows the car to have a shorter wheelbase. Sporting a fiberglass body, the SS also features body-integrated exhaust outlets, headlights and roll bar.

We don't often see Corvairs mentioned in Hemmings Muscle Machines Magazine, but the April Edition of the magazine contains a review of the 2022 Cadillac CT4-V Blackwing. Writer Jeff Koch has high praise for this high performance sport sedan with a 472 hp twin turbo V6 engine. Apparently, Cadillac is planning to go all electric in a few years and this model will be phased out. So here comes the Corvair reference - "The model joins Corvair, Fiero, Grand National, Allante' and B body Impala SS on that list of cars that GM killed once it got them right.

Six Standouts from Amelia Island's Cars & Community Event

1964 Chevrolet Corvair Fitch Sprint:

Before GM got it together to start making the Corvair's handling safer at speed, John Fitch was there to offer the enthusiast suspension-tuning parts for making the performance match the advertising. One of only two Corvairs I spotted the whole weekend (the other being the Greenbriar van in the gallery), I was in awe over all the details, including a four-carb engine (not offered by Chevrolet until 1965, but a popular mod before that) and a lot of handy interior accessories that I found quite inspirational.
