

OLD BUSINESS

1. VOTE SLATE OF OFFICERS

2. WHEELS FOR WHISKERS CAR SHOW

- Patrick Murphy, with help from Joe Pendolino, is working on a car show at the Pets Alive shelter at 7007 Campbell Blvd. Pets Alive finds homes for cats and dogs and Patrick Murphy is a volunteer there.
- b. The dates would be August 13 with a rain date of August 27, chosen because of few conflicts the date of the 13th and a show the following week that Patrick and Joe work, should it rain on the 13th.
- c. There will be a \$15 registration. There will be dash plaques. Also, hot dogs and drinks will be sold. There will be a basket raffle and 50/50. The shelter will be open for

Spent a bit of time, making a press fixture for rear arm busing removal.



Milestone moment, last item that I can unbolt from the body of the car is done. Once I blast and power coat the front items, just have to finish stripping all inside paint and insulation and strip the underside.








Converting over to 5 lug for a larger selection of rims and giving drop spindles in the front a try which take the LM Hub. Used the disk rotor and a shim to hub centric align the bolt pattern and used a transfer punch to transfer the pattern.







Also repacked and re-shimmed the bearings while I had them off. Axles power coated and longer studs installed.
