September Aircooler: Guest speaker for next meeting will be a rep from J.C.Taylor insurance company. Romeo Peach Festival parade is Sept. 5th. Saline parade is Sept. 10th. Treasury balance is \$720.29. Full page pictures of the experimental Flat 10 cyl. Engine. Two members were added to the Masters of Disaster club. Dan Weir's Powerglide gave up a few miles from the CORSA convention in Ashville. Ken Pepke had an oil burning problem with his engine and used 48 quarts of oil to Ashville and back. A tech tip about U-joints was mentioned that the grease in a new one is just to prevent rusting and you need to pump some good grease thru them to displace the light oil.

October Aircooler: Our annual Frankenmuth trip and chicken dinner is Oct.15.

Kathy Mucha's dad Ab Ives won a sterling silver trophy at the Hiram Walker show with his 1920 Overland. Bob Kirkman wrote that a neighbor Ron Clark had a visitor at his shop that had an overhead cam engine in his Corvair. The fellow said his dad worked at Chevy engineering. We suspect the engine was once installed in the Astro 1 car. The Corvair count is now up to 81 members own 232 Corvairs.

November Aircooler: Marvin Granger joined the club along with 3 others. A roster of all members will be printed in the December Aircooler so you must pay your dues by the November meeting to be included. Bob Kirkman talked about building Stubby (his shortened Corvair). Members asked to bring pictures to the meeting. Membership at 108 and 58 members came to last meeting. In the drive your Corvair points race it was mentioned that half of our members haven't driven their Corvair at all or forgot to report it. Ken Hand reported that he and Wes Irons have made a one-hour long movie about Corvairs and it will be shown on TV. A Feb. event will be a tour to the Henry Ford Museum. Treasurers report is \$435.07. A DACC member now has the second to last 1969 Corvair, serial 5999. Come to the next meeting to find out who. A roster of all members was included in the Dec. Aircooler. The final Corvair account is 101 members own 277 Corvairs. ■

Another Red Corvair Article by Pete Kohler

How about another Corvair adventure? This one showed up on an Internet site called "Corvair Center Forum". This is a message board originally offered by the Corvair Club of San Diego, California. It is now a service supported by the national club, CORSA. A red late model Corvair parked a barn many decades ago and currently surrounded by so much "stuff" it was hard to tell much of anything about the car other than it's red paint. Since my last two Corvair purchases came out of Indiana this one was a bonus residing in nearby Parma, Michigan. A must see!

A few weeks ago Ian Smith and I arranged a visit to the barn in Parma. Yes, the car was there. Yes, it was red. It looked solid, but the jury would be out until the car could come out of it's hiding place. A previously suggested value was known and the owner/seller was hoping for a bit more. I was hoping he wasn't basing his hopes after watching some of the recent big-time auctions...

A second visit to the barn was planned this time with a trailer and \$1500 (fifteen pictures of Ben Franklin) as that is what the seller wanted. VP Mike Anstine came along to help extract this beauty from the barn. We met Mike Hurt there and the three of us were pleasantly surprised to see the car already out of the stall and parked in the driveway. That was a good thing as three of the four tires had gotten tired (pun??) of holding up their corner of the Monza and gone flat. Really flat. Next step was to back the trailer into position and hook up the electric winch.

After a bit of maneuvering all was set and the car rested on the trailer deck. Now we could take a better look at our find. It is a 1965 Monza coupe with an earlier engine (1963?) and a powerglide transmission. The interior sports a pair of black 1968 Strato buckets. The front carpet is missing but that just lets us see the floor pans - which are in great shape! The story behind the car is that it came from "out West". That makes sense since this Corvair is a Southern California native being built at the LA plant. It started out life blue, but at some point it was painted resale red. The paint job isn't bad and it might polish out. No obvious rust on the body is a big plus. Once back in Farmington Hills a message was sent to Tom Tennant with pics from Mike. I knew that our past President Grant Tennant was still looking for his first Corvair. I have always thought that a perfect first Corvair would be a late model coupe or sedan with a 2-carb engine and an automatic transmission. Having a floor and being Corvair-shaped even better! It didn't take long to hear back from Tom that the car

So now Grant will have his very first Corvair. The car will need some TLC, but the engine does turn over with a 3/4" wrench on the crank pulley. Mom and Dad should be happy as the engine is probably a base 80 HP version. Don't worry Grant, maybe the garage squad can help build up a newer, faster engine somewhere down the road. The wheels that came with the car are from a 1980's Pontiac and they look pretty good. The original tires are raised white letter ones that proclaim "Bonneville Super Wide 70". They will be replaced even before the car makes it's way up to the Tennant compound in Hadley Twp.




