

Meeting place ----- Tim Horton's in Lockport on Transit Rd


Leave Tim Horton's ----- 9:15 am



I would like to thank Chuck Facklam for including us for the special event at the Buffalo Transportation Museum. We got to hear Jeff Mahl tell the story of his grandfather George Schuster's epic journey driving a 1907 Buffalo built Thomas Flyer from NY to Paris to win the Great Race of 1908! The story is interesting as it started in the dead of winter, no heat, no windshield, no AAA, no anti-freeze, no snowplows, and very few roads! 22,000 miles in 169 days. The car and driver remain Buffalo's only championship win.

We also got to see two Thomas Flyers run and drive on museum property This one had a 784 cubic inch, 6-cylinder with 2 spark plugs per cylinder, developing 70 horsepower with 5 and 1/2 inch bore and 5 and 1/2 inch stroke.



This 1903 Thomas on the other hand had a 106 cubic inch one cylinder motor. Fenders shook on this one.
