In Hales Corners, WI, the Holz Chevrolet dealership holds it annual car show on July 4th. Over 400 cars




of all makes and models (2008 and earlier) fill the lot.

How many Corvairs make it there? Maybe a maximum of 3 out of over 400. Cars that are older than 1970 probably make up 25% of the show field. Kids going by the Corvairs are intrigued by the engine placement, it's simplicity and the overall look. They ask questions. How do we harness that curiosity and turn it into an stronger interest to keep a car club alive?

Facebook, Instagram, and other social media outlets only go so far. Getting the name and imagery back into the current mainstream is the challenge. How else can we do that? Well, kids always want that first car to drive so maybe a club could find a way to sponsor a restoration or two through a school, trade school, or local car dealership? Perhaps it could be made so that either the kid gets the restored car, or it gets sold and the funds go to a scholarship?

Come on—let's find a way to keep our club alive. Send me some of your thoughts and ideas—let's show them at the 2026 Corsa Convention that Mid-Maryland Corvair Club has a growing and energetic membership!

#### Going to Clarks for the First Time?

If you're going to Clark's for their 50th Birthday Celebration, getting there can be a challenge. If you take the highways and toll roads, the trip is anywhere is around 7 hours (426 miles), a no-toll scenic route is about 8 (460 miles).


My suggestion is to take the scenic route—slower speeds and beautiful views as you drive through rural Pennsylvania (with the exception of Harrisburg), New York (with the exception of Albany), and then the mountains of Massachusetts.

From Fitzgerald Auto Mall Frederick, follow US-15N to PA581E in Camp Hill. Take the PA-581E exit from US-15N. This will take about an hour 10 min (68.5 mi).

Take I-81N and I=88E to NY-7 in Latham. Take exit 7 from I-87N. About 5hrs and 2 mins. (321 miles).

Continue on NY-7E. Take NY-2E to MA-2E in Shelburne.


