Iron Horse Bar & Grill

11105 E Sprague Ave., Spokane Valley
Decent place on par with
Longhorn. (But not baroque) They have
a wide variety of appetizers, salads,
burgers, sandwiches on the menu.
There is a spot in the grill that's semiprivate & they are happy to
accommodate us.

Poole's Public House

12310 N Ruby Rd. (Corner of Ruby and Hastings, just east of Mead HS.) North Spokane

The menu has a little of both the above choices, the food is excellent. They have a spot off the main part of the restaurant to seat a large group.
