EMPI - Performance Parts



On the next page, you'll find a full-page ad for EMPI performance parts for Corvairs. Way back, in the 1960s, a company named EMPI sold performance and accessory parts for Volkswagens and Corvairs.

EMPI was one of many companies hawking accessories for foreign and compact cars at that time. So many of those companies came and went: IECO, EELCO, Runyon, Latham, Judson and others. But a few survived and EMPI is one of survivors. Here it is, 2024, and they are still going strong.

Not surprising, EMPI no longer sells parts for Corvairs. But true to form, they still specialize in parts for cars with air-cooled engines, namely Volkswagens. They sell parts under their own name as well as other manufacturers.

So, in the EMPI list of products, you'll see parts manufactured not only by EMPI, but also Moroso, Kennedy, ARP, Pertronix, Wildwood and many more. EMPI is the middleman for those other manufacturers, a jobber.

The array of parts is really outstanding. The online catalog includes everything from carburetor jets to long block engines. And they are serious about their engines. "EMPI Long Block Engines are hand assembled in Southern California with all-new all-EMPI matched and approved components by VW racing legend Jack Sacchette....No core re-

quired, no long lead times.".

Getting back to the old days, the ad shown on page 3 indicates EMPI used to deal only in mail-order sales. Fill out the handy coupon, mail it in, and receive their catalog. Fill out an order form, enclose it in an envelope with a check and they mail the parts to your door. Direct sales. Now, their catalog is online and to buy EMPI parts, you need to contact a local EMPI dealer. So, you are no longer dealing directly with the company, which by the way, is located in Anaheim, California.

You may be wondering how to find an EMPI dealer. It's actually pretty easy. They are listed on the EMPI website and – get this – there are 923 of them across the world. There's even a dealer in Bangkok!

OK, now for the big question: The word "EMPI" an acronym. What does it stand for?

Car Life's Special Corvair Issue!

Hi Everybody! This month's Fifth Wheel is chock-full 'o ads from the August 1962 issue of Car Life magazine. It was Car Life's "Special Corvair Issue".

LVCC VP John Egerton lent his copy of this collectible magazine to your Editor who then scanned the ads and pasted them here. It's amazing to see all the aftermarket parts and accessories that were offered for Corvairs back in '62.

In addition to the ads, which are always fun to read because of the ridiculously low prices being demanded for the parts, the August 1962 issue had lots of articles that should be near and dear to all Corvair enthusiasts. Topics included road tests on the 102 hp Monza, 150 hp Monza Spyder, GM's Super Spyder, John Fitch Sprint, Corvair Speciale - pronounced "speh-chal-ehe" - by Pininfarina, Gene Windfield's wild Forecasta showcar, and an technical article titled "Inside the Corvair Engine".

Trivia: John's copy of that Car Life magazine still has the original mailing label attached, so we know it was originally sent to a person named "John Karc" in Bath, PA. Is anybody familiar with that name? Was Mr. Karc a Corvair guy?



Per a motion made and seconded by Greg Dittrich and John Egerton respectively, the minutes of the January 10th meeting, as published in the last Fifth Wheel were approved by acclamation.

Per a motion made and seconded by Dan Schmidt and Jeff Strausser respectively, the treasury report as published in the last Fifth Wheel newsletter were approved by acclamation. After the transmission arrives, Jeff will be tasked with bolting the transmission, differential and bell-housing back together and installing the complete powertrain back into his Corvair. This is NOT a one man job so we're looking for a couple of good volunteers to lend a hand.

Tech Tip by Brian O'Neill

I got to thinking recently about driving our Corvairs. Unfortunately, many of our members will say, yes, I drive my Corvair. But what they mean is they drive it in the warm weather. Many of our cars sleep all winter long. Yes, you don't get any salt or snow on the car but there are some downsides.

I'm not advocating that you go out there in the next snowstorm to prove how great a Corvair can be in the snow. What I am advocating is that when there is no snow on the ground and the roads are clean and dry, take your Corvair out for half an hour or so. Why?


Because letting the car sit for a couple of months can have some effects that are not all that great. First of all, your oil can start to break down especially if you didn't put new oil in the engine just before you put the cart asleep. Tires get flat spotted. Sure, they go back to round after a while but do you really want that thumping noise first time you drive the car?


Also, the lifters in the engine bleed down and sometimes can take as much as 20 minutes of driving to pump back up. You can let the engine idle for a long, long time and they will not pump up they as need to be under load.

Another thing that can happen is that the valve springs take a "set" in the position they are in when you shut off the engine and parked the car for a couple of months. Again, no serious long-term issues but it makes starting the car hard and when you do get it to run it runs poorly.

So, when the roads are clean and dry take that car for a spin!









