Minutes of the Last Meeting

March 7, 2024

Josh got the regular meeting started around 7:00 PM following a short Board meeting. When the room was opened, Ray, Josh, Harry and I were quickly joined by Seth, Christy, Jeffrey, Paul, Don, Buck, Cameron and Peter. I hope I included everyone.

Treasury Report: Harry reported that the bank balance stood at \$4366.26.

Membership: Josh did not report any new members this month although a few have expressed interest. Harrty said the the last CORSA Club Membership form asked for a current list of Officers and the latest roster. Josh said he would take care of it.

Old Business: Nothing mentioned.

New Business: Josh received an email from someone in Nevada that is helping a lady sell her Corvair after her husband died. She has a '60 Monza Coupe, a solid project car that use to belong to Chuck Forge (a Porsche racer).



Chuck used to use the Corvair to test race tracks amongst other thinks. It's a Californis car and has all of the paper work. No price has been set yet. See Josh for more details.

2025 National Convention: Buck asked about the 2025 Convention in Santa Maria. He has access to many cones to line the auto-cross and can help

set things up. Josh will get him in contact with Vince Petrie of Central Coast Corsa, the host club for the convention. Josh said they will certainly need Concourse judges. You would only be assigned a limited area (tires, interiors, etc.) and they train you so you don't have to know about everything. Buck said years ago he brought a race car to a convention in Lake Tahoe and entered in the concourse as a lark. When the judge asked "show me your turn signals" Buck stuck his hand out saying "this is left, and this is right". "Now test the horn" and Buck responded "beep, beep". He didn't score very high in this regard, but it was fun and he almost got a bronze medal. At VairFest this year we will have a good opportunity to gauge just what help will be needed.

Events: Ray said there were Stage First events (a cars and coffee type gathering) at the Marin Civic Center. This is a fascinating building designed by Frank Lloyd Wright. Josh said the California Auto Museum in Sacramento has a Corvair display. Also the Autorama at Cal Expo has a car coral and the Sacramento club has an area reserved for Corvairs. If interested in bringing your Corvair, contact Josh for the forms to fill out.

Tech: Peter found the Corvair he was looking for! He bought a '65 Corsa 140, 4 speed from Terry Brunke in Colorado. It is being shipped out and should arrive in a few days. Terry's father Al Brunke raced Corvairs. Peter said the car ran well but didn't have much power. Body seemed solid, nothing but some surface rust and the interior seemed pretty clean. The first thing

he will do is a through cleanup and then go through the engine. Terry also has other Corvairs for sale. A Rampside that needs some work, a '63 or '64 Monza that was in Car and Driver a while back. While Peter was in Colorado he called his wife who happened to be watching an Elvis special at the time. Turns out Elvis bought his wife, Priscilla, a '63 Corvair.



You guessed it, Peter's new Corvair is now named "Priscilla" compliments of his wife. Seth said a lot of good changes were made in '65, the best shifting trans and of course the 140, 4 carb engine. We hope you all had a great St Patrick's Day weekend and enjoyed the beautiful weather.



CORSA and the Corvair forum run by Scott Howey. Both have very knowledgeable members. Peter asked about oil. He heard that Mobil 1 10W30 was a good oil to use. But with or without Zinc? Seth said 10W30 was good for our area and Zn is not necessary for older engines. They already have Zn plated out where it is needed (lifters, cam shaft, etc.). It doesn't wash away and more would not be needed.

Jeffrey asked about gas additives. Would they help pinging? Josh said he uses Lucas Octane Booster and adds it



He lives in a hilly area and his Corvairs don't ping at all. Jeffrey asked if this helps "after running". Seth said that was usually caused by carbon build up in the chambers. Some people dribble some fluids through the carbs like Sea



Christy suggested using a spray bottle to give you better control. Jeffrey said he was taking his Corvair to Mel's tomorrow to pin point the cause of the noise he has been hearing. He suspects it's the flywheel (Ouch!). While it is up on the rack he will replace the thermostats. He pick up some NOS units from Scott Morton. He is still not sure if he will be getting the Nash Fan this year or not. It depends if the extra unit they always make is needed or not. He either will getting a fan or his check back.

Seth said he has a new product to replace the lower barbell (lower strut rods) for the rear suspension on late models. They are adjustable so you can change the camber easily. When racing a street car, at the track you can set the camber for the race and then set it back for the drive home. It is \$325 for the pair. Christy ask where Seth advertised his products. Seth said mainly on the Facebook Corvair Racer's page and Corvair Owner's Group. Seth said his new steering box is selling well. It looks like it will be a constant item. People will either want quicker steering or to replace worn gears. Christy asked if it would affect the steering radius. Seth said no, not like shorter arms. Seth said he wished he has access to the factory shorter arms. Nobody is making them but he is trying to work with a new

outfit that makes similar arms. Seth said the factory quick-steering arms were designed for 4" rock hard 650/13 tires. With 7" sticky tires you won't like quick steering! Christy asked about adding the new steering box to his '63. Seth said for that year it will bolt right in. For other years he has adapters available.

Don said that Dan Smith's son was selling off his Corvair collection that is stored in Antioch. Don went to look at a Lakewood for someone in Connecticut. It's a California car with minimal rust but it lacks an engine and trans. But the guy backed out. Clark asked how Dan was doing. He moved to Oregon several years ago. Don said he was fine but recovering from a bad car accident. They will be selling the Antioch property and clearing out all of the Corvair stuff.




