



In our April meeting, I brought in a bucket seat extender and we discussed the benefits and shortfalls with the installation. Several of our club members never knew these existed or have ever seen them.

Yes, they add about three inches of rearward travel and allow those tall drivers additional leg straightening but for those short drivers, the extender also moves the front seat adjustment back that three inch travel amount.

We also watched two videos on fuel pump disassembly with revisions to avoid fuel draining into the engine when a pump malfunction occurs.

Another reminder for all CORSA members to vote for our eastern directors. Your vote can be completed by physical or computer ballot and the voting period ends 05/31/24. Of additional importance is CORSA's proposed bylaws update which, in length, can be found in May's issue or in the CORSA website. In order for the bylaws to become effective, they must now be approved by a two-thirds majority of CORSA's voting members. Voting here can also be completed online or by completing the hard copy ballot on the inside cover of the May issue. This voting period ends 07/01/24.

# **Member Spotlight: Dick Kaetzel**

I was born at hospital in Brunswick, MD on August 10, 1944 (also my mother's birthday!)

After graduation from Boonsboro High School in 1962, I went to work at Beachley Furniture Co. as an upholsterer. In December of that year, I got my first new car- a 1963 Corvair Monza 80 HP 4 speed.

In 1965, I went into the Air Force. I was in Texas for basic training and tech school for jet aircraft maintenance. After Texas I was stationed in Hawaii for 3 years.

After the Air Force, I came home and went to work for the railroads: The B&O, The Chessie System, CSX and finally Amtrak. After the railroad I went to work for the Methodist Church Camp, first as maintenance director then as the camp manager. I retired in 2009 after 23 years.

Over the years I have had over 50 Corvairs- all years from 1960-1969. I had a 1969 convertible with 4 speed and a 140 HP from the factory. The car was in a barn in Hancock, MD, and had been put there in 1992 when Mr. Donnelly passed away. I worked on the car and put it back on the road. I have had models of all years- 4-door and 2-door sedans, convertibles, as well as a 1962 Rampside and a 1962 station wagon. One that I have never had is a Greenbrier.

I have traveled to Jacksonville, FL, Bay City, Michigan, Hartford, Connecticut, West Virginia, Virginia and Pennsylvania to purchase Corvairs. I like the ones that have been off the road for years. I go over them and get them back on the road. I have saved a lot of Corvairs over the years!

At this time, I have a 1961 station wagon, 1963 Monza Convertible with 140 HP and a 1966 Monza 4-door with 110 HP on the road. The Corvair is the only car I like to work on. I am starting to slow down and only working on my own Corvairs.

I married my wife Vicki in 1976. We have a daughter (Sherri), two sons (Ted and Bryan) and 6 wonderful grandchildren. Over the years I helped manage and coach little league baseball teams. I was also the manager and player on a men's slow pitch softball team.
