

Apology From The Editor:

My apologies to the MMCC membership for the missed newsletter in June. As you read in the June letter "From The President", I was very heavily involved in the Cadillac LaSalle Club (CLC) Convention held at the same site our 2026 Convention will be held.

With everything that was needed to get things organized, my attention was not on getting out a newsletter- it was on trying to fix things that were extremely inefficient. Needless to say, there were a LOT of things that I made note of during that process that I will be sharing with my fellow CORSA Convention Committee members to ensure we don't make the same mistakes.

The primary issue that I saw (and heard) was "we've always done it this way" (or at least for the last 15 or 20 years). As much as a lot of us don't like change, working smarter, not harder, is the key. As our current membership ages and we want to bring younger folks into the organization, we can't afford to repeat this mistake. What may have worked fifteen years to twenty years ago is now outdated, and the process needs to be tweaked and refined for the present with the future in mind.

The biggest area that needed improvement was the scheduling of volunteers, and it was on this subject that I made a presentation about during our last meeting. I do have to say that I was a little disappointed in what appeared to be a lack of enthusiasm from several members on volunteering. The CLC has what CORSA has been doing- having an "Event Chairman" who is responsible for a specific event- getting the list of prospective volunteers and calling each one to see if they'd volunteer for the event, and then filling in the open time slots (such as hospitality suite, registration, and show field security).

We literally did not know what events were short-staffed until 5 days before the start of the convention! We somehow made it through with several people taking extra shifts and unfortunately missing some things that they wanted to do. The Event Chairpersons each complained that no one else wants to do it, so they end up doing it year after year. As Tom and I have both said numerous times, <u>THIS WILL NOT BE THE WAY WE DO IT IN 2026!</u> The list of volunteers and the scheduling will be done on the computer- all we need is one person from each event to be the leader *at the time of the event*.

I've combined the June and July newsletters, hence the two "From The President" articles, and I plan to be back on track for August. That newsletter should be out around the 30th, barring any unforeseen issues. Our "Member Spotlight" will be Robert "Bob" McNamara who has three Corvairs in his harem. As noted in several places in this newsletter, we really need our members to step up and provide stories and pictures of their Corvairs! I know a lot of you like getting awardsthink of this as getting an award as your story and pictures go WORLDWIDE. This newsletter is sent to every CORSA chapter via CORSA's mailing list.
