

As most of you know I got my Yenko Stinger back a year ago after having been gone for 18 years. In the past year I have been to several car shows some over 60 miles away. When I got the car back it still had the BF Goodrich TA's on it that I installed 22 years ago. They only have 7000 miles on them and had been inside all 18 years. I thought several times, "I should probably replace those tires, but they look nearly new".

I decided to go to the Lake Afton car show on the 9<sup>th</sup>, as I got within 10 miles of the show I noticed a vibration, bet a tire is going bad I thought to myself. I made it to the show and figured I could drive home slowly, and it would be OK. As I was leaving the show at 2:00 a fellow stopped me and said ", your rear tire is pretty bad".
