Saturday, November 21, 1:00 pm, at North River Tavern.





Happy December.

So, what's going on at Corvair Pergatory this month:

Hurricane cleanup continued in November. 7 more 50 ft trees come down. The first 14 were moved to

the curb with the aid of a friend and his tractor. The next 7 are where they fell and need to be moved to the curb so FEMA can pick them up.

'66 Corvair LS motor implant: Is ready to go to the LS tuning shop, Finally

'66 Convertible PG back from paint shop touch up and ready to sell.

'64 Greenbrier (new to me): has all new running gear and only on spot of rust on the driver rear fender

bottom. Got it running, replaced the alternator fan and rerouting the oil pressure sending unit. Lubed the accelerator pedal and cable to free it up. Working on the doors and windows to get them working properly.

'62 Monza Wagon: It is stripped for body work and paint. Finished the headliner with plenty of

wrinkles. It was a nasty job. I would not recommend it to anyone. Stripped and painted a spyder dash,




