Minutes of the Last Meeting

April 3, 2025

Josh got the regular meeting started around 7:00 PM following a short Board meeting. When the room was opened, Josh, Harry, and I were quickly joined by Seth, Chris, Don, Lane, Peter, Craig, and Christy. I hope I have included everyone. Notably absent was Carl who is still on vacation to Spain & France.

Treasury Report: The bank balance as reported in the last Newsletter was \$5129. Josh mentioned that the Club's web hosting outfit has increased their price by 250% (from \$11/month to \$24/month). Josh intends to switch to WordPress which at \$7/month is even a bit less than we are currently paying.

Membership: Josh did not report any new members this month. But there have been inquiries.

Old Business: Nothing mentioned this month.

New Business: Josh setup a Corvair Forum on the Club's web site. This will be for SFBA members to get help. Josh said that the CPF Scholarship Program was now open. They have a \$1000 scholarship available and Corvanatics also has a \$500 scholarship available. If you know anyone heading off to college (or even trade school), they can apply. Who knows, it may even pay for a book or two. Josh said Sarah Bruce is running this program this year. Contact Josh for more info, application forms, etc.

2025 Convention: Josh reported that CORSA had arranged more hotel

rooms but time is running out. Don't wait to make your reservations. It was reported that Central Coast Corsa had received \$8500 in donations from the various clubs to help offset the cost of the Convention. Clark brought up the proposed Parking Volunteer schedule. Lane and Don said they were okay with this but Peter said it was doubtful he would be able to attend. Clark will look for other volunteers to help fill the few gaps in the schedule. At the last Convention Planning meeting, it was suggested that people consider bringing a folding chair or two to help out the Corvair Car Show area. Josh said he had a few he could bring. Be sure to put your name on them! Bruce intends to bring one or two Corvairs but not the Yenko Stinger as he wasn't able to find a secure location to keep it in the evenings.

Phil's Corvair Work Party: The date Saturday, April 26 has been set for the next Work Party to work on Phil's Corvair. Starting around 9:00 AM, the goal this time is to get the interior cleaned up, remove seats, carpets, etc. in preparation for the new items. This is only expected to take a couple of hours. Josh reported that he tested the radio, and it works great even with a make-shift antenna in his garage. He also painted the kick panels (they came out great) plus he cleaned up the radio bezel. Don got the leaking tires fixed. Turns out they were leaking around the beads which just needed to be cleaned and the tires re-mounted.

Events: Peter mentioned a cars and coffee (actually a Cabernet and Pizza)

in San Carlos. They are having a special Corvair day. Probably the third Sunday in June, he will let us know. Seth felt that between SFBA and Valley Corsa we could have ten or so Corvairs show up.

Tech: Josh said Bruce got the Turbo engine back in Marc's '65 Corsa. He had Pallo go through the engine. One of the heads was warped but Pallo was able to fix it (or replace it?). Must not have been too bad. Bruce is delighted with how well it is now running!

Don said he had ordered the parts for Phil's car from Clark's and some have come in already. The seat covers and headliner were boxed and needed to be opened up and kept flat to prevent creases. Don will send the invoice to Harry. Parts total \$2090 but then there is tax and shipping.

Christy asked if anyone had heard from Carl? He was wondering what the issue was with his engine. He is keeping us in suspense! Christy said the Sacramento club (CCRC) has a new V.P. who is organizing monthly events. Last month they went to Suttor Creek. They had lunch in Gold Coast at Gold Dust Pizza. Boy was that good pizza! For fun the VP made up a rally sheet with pictures of features they were to identify along the way. Christy thought that was fun.

Peter said his Corvair was coming along. A lot slower than he had hoped. He now has the suspension installed. He used heavy duty springs from Clark's. Now he has the interior torn up preparing for some new parts. Pe-

With the spring weather finally here, we hope you are able to take your Corvair for a spin. If you do, please remember to take photos. Ok, with that out of the way, a couple of things of note to share...

Digital Assets

We have been using wix as our website host since the refresh in 2019. Everything was great and the rates stayed fair. Out of the blue and right before renewal, they informed us that they were raising rates from \$11/mo to \$24/mo while decreasing our storage. Payment is in 2 year intervals, so that would come out to a \$576 bill.

At the last meeting, we all agreed that this was a no-go. Josh is currently looking for a more reasonable host that suits our needs, so the site either may be temporarily down or may look different the next time you visit. The domain name is paid for and will remain the same. If you know of a host that offers drag & drop for around \$10/mo, let Josh know.

It was asked if there will be any changes to zoom. The answer to that is no, for now. We believe that zoom and the website are essential benefits for the long term health of the club, so we will do everything in our power to keep costs as low as possible.

While the meta platforms are problematic in other areas, they are free and where the people are, so those will continue uninterrupted.

• 66 Corsa Update

We are moving forward with Phil's donated 66 Corsa. With the club's approval, Don has purchased the necessary parts to fix up the interior. Some of the interior parts (door panels, kick panels, radio) have been repaired & cleaned and are ready for install. Don has also repaired the two tires that had slow leaks. We are going to do a work party at Don's in Antioch on April 26. If you want to attend, let us know.





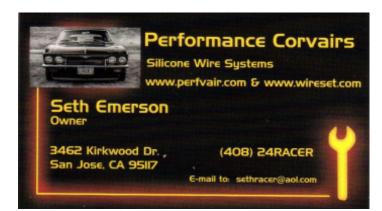
