My Corvair odyssey.

At the moment, I own only one Corvair. It's the 4th Corvair I've owned. The other three were a '66 140HP Corsa coupe that I bought in December of 1971 and two '69 500 coupes that I bought sometime later. At no time during this period did I own more than one Corvair. Both '69s were 95HP with a 3speed and ended up being scrapped. Unfortunately, I didn't save the VIVs for the '69 registry. There was a gap of about 15 years when I didn't own any Corvairs. I bought my current Corvair in June of 1994 from the insurance money when my 1986 Dodge Omni GLH Turbo was totaled. It is a 1966 140HP Monza with A/C and Corsa badging and the previous owner was upfront in telling me that. One of the things that attracted me to the car was that someone had customized the front with tunneled headlights. I liked the look, so I bought it. He also included a spare 140HP engine. The tires on it were so bad that I had traction problems in the rain, so I bought a set of BF Goodrich Radial TAs which were a world of difference better. The car was originally sold in Arizona, and I have no idea how or when it got to Michigan. Since purchasing the car, I have made numerous changes to both the mechanicals and body of the car. Since the previous owner included the warranty booklet with the car, I know that it had the original engine. At some point before I bought it, someone swapped out the stronger '66-'69 4-speed transaxle and put in a '65 transaxle. I bought a '66 transaxle off of eBay and had it as a backup if the '65 transaxle broke. In. 2005, it broke (fresh clutch, wide tires and a 1-2 speed shift), stripping the input gear and counter gear of all teeth. At that point, I was glad to have the later transaxle and discovered the issues with the difference in length, mostly with the shift rod. The other major mechanical change was in 2015 when I swapped out the engine in the car for a completely rebuilt engine. Prior to that, I had put the spare engine in the car, so the rebuilt engine had the original crankcase (and not much else). One of the first things I did to the interior was to replace the stock steering wheel with a smaller aftermarket wheel. Later, I switched to a slightly larger aftermarket steering wheel but still smaller than the stock one. Surprisingly, the seats were in pretty good shape despite coming from Arizona. However, the seats had cloth inserts so I'm pretty sure they were reupholstered before I bought it. Unfortunately, the seat foams were deteriorating, and my seating

position was gradually getting lower. I found some bucket seats I liked on eBay and as I couldn't find a bench seat that went with the bucket seats, I decided to buy four and have bucket seats in both front and back. That was around 2006 and at about the same time, the A/C compressor clutch decided to come apart which forced me to upgrade the A/C system. That, along with other mechanical upgrades, was published in earlier Aircoolers. After ten years, the rebuilt engine seems to be showing some wear, so I'm working on that as well as some suspension work on the front end. What I've shared is just an overview, since going into all of the details of owning my Corvair for over 30 years would result in a VERY long article. I'm including a before and after picture to show how the appearance has changed as well as a picture of the wrecked GLH that brought me back to Corvairs.

Sloan Summer Fair show in Flint

Every year in May I write something for the Aircooler about the Sloan Summer Fair show in Flint. Years ago, we had 20+ Corvairs on display but for some reason the last few years it has been less than 10. Some of our "old timers" have passed on or sold their cars but there are a lot of new people, both dues paying members and those on Facebook. There have been some changes in the show since the first one in the early 70's, like going to a two-day event. What I have seen is Saturday has turned into the "big" day with more cars and people and Sunday a little less attended but still a good number of people. Late June is also a time for graduation open houses and family vacations so maybe that comes into play. I go both days but still like to stay all day on Sunday and watch everyone drive past our reserved area on the way out. Speaking of that, we have one of the best parking spots in the show field, lots of shade if it's hot and sunny and easy to find just past the check-in tent. If we don't have a good turnout we may lose this cool spot. Being that Brian and Marvin Granger are involved in both our club and the Summer Fair Committee helps, but WE NEED TO SHOW UP AND SUPPORT THIS SHOW. You can mail in the paper registration form that will be available at the June meeting, register online or show up and register at the tent when you get there. The profit from the show goes towards supporting the automotive collection of the museum. Several years ago, it underwent a 26 million renovation and is a great science and learning center for kids, maybe not the history and car museum it was years ago but there are a lot more 8-11-year-old kids that will enjoy the exhibits. And not as many "old" people that like to see old cars parked in a building, would we rather see them on the grass and rolling down the road. You can enjoy a really good grilled Kogel hot dog or a burger from my friends at Hot Dog Heaven and wander around the grounds checking out all the different cars and trucks that attend this annual event. I-75 North is under construction, but you should be able to roll along OK to I-475 North that is also under construction. My suggestion is to avoid the freeways and just take Dixie Hwy North through Grand Blanc, stay on Saginaw St into Burton and Downtown Flint and enjoy a ride on the "new" bricks of Saginaw St. Turn RIGHT on Kearsley St. just past the Flat Lot Five Automotive Heritage Statues, there is a large Flint sign on the corner. Kearsley St. will take you through the U of M Flint Campus. Just over the freeway turn Left on the service Dr. at the light and then make a Right on Longway Blvd and follow the signs to the show car entrance on the right. Look for all the Corvairs on the left as you enter the grounds. There is more to see than just old cars and trucks, you can check out the Applewood Estate, the former home of C.S. Mott, a former Corvair owner, Founder of GM in the early years and a Philanthropist who helped build Flint into the Automotive powerhouse of the early 19th. century. See registration attachment.
