Saturday July 22nd, 8am - 3pm: "Wheels for Wildlife" @ The Wild Animal Sanctuary, 1946 Co Rd 53, Keenesburg, CO. The Wild Animal Sanctuary is the largest sanctuary of its kind and one of the oldest in the United States. This is a rare opportunity for you and your family to be able to not only visit the facility, but make an impact on the care these rescued animals receive. Admission to the show is FREE, admission to the park is regular price. They have 10 acres dedicated to parking, so there should be no problem in fitting about 100 Corvairs in there, right? This is a fundraising event to help care for the more than 450 rescued lions, tigers, bears, and other large carnivores that call the Sanctuary home and collect the critical funding that will allow the Sanctuary to continue to rescue animals in need! 
