Re: **Update HB 13-1071 Register Collector's Motor Vehicles**

TR 13-19

Following the August implementation of House Bill 13-1071 the Title and Registration Sections have worked with the bill sponsors to update the implementation to match their intent. The bill sponsors are evaluating doing a clean-up bill that will match these implementation changes.

With these implementation changes, effective immediately and upon completion of CSTARS programming, collector vehicles can be broken into three different categories.

The first category of Collector Vehicles are 1975 and older vehicles. These vehicles are not required to obtain an emissions test and are not required to sign the DR 2839 Collector's Item Affidavit to renew.

The second category of collector vehicles is Collector Vehicles 1976 or later that were registered prior to September 1, 2009. These vehicles are not required to obtain a passing emissions test or sign the DR 2839 Collector's Item Affidavit to renew. These vehicles will remain in this second category until a change of ownership occurs. The new owner may register the vehicle as a Collector Vehicle, but at that time will be placed into the final category below.

The final category of collector vehicles is Collector Vehicles that are model year of at least 32- years old. This means that in 2013, vehicles that are model year 1981 or older qualify as collectors; in 2014, the model year will be 1982; in 2015 the model year will be 1983, etc. This category is broken
