

down into two sub-categories. If the vehicle is being registered in the emissions program area, the applicant will be required to sign the DR 2839 Collector's Item Affidavit and pass emissions to register and renew. If a Collector Vehicle that are model year of at least 32-years old is being registered and not in the emissions program area, these vehicles are not required to obtain an emissions test and are not required to sign the DR 2839 Collector's Item Affidavit.

With HB 13-071 the Title and Registration Sections have created a couple of training tools that are available to the counties. First, a job aide was created as an overview for Collector's Vehicles and is available on the CSTARTS Icon by selecting 3) Training Information, Job Aides, Decision Tools and then 2) Job Aides/Decision Tools. A presentation of the overview of Collector's Vehicles was developed. The counties will be notified once it has been posted to the CSTARTS Icon.

Programming is currently being completed for this bill and will be updated in the monthly CSTARTS programming update.

Below is a chart clarifying which Collector Vehicles model year requires emissions testing and affidavit completion.
