Ken added that a \$100 donation was received from Mid Continent Corvair Assn. since last meeting.

Membership-In January dues are due for 2020.

SeeMore-in the process of getting the trailer registered. Still researching but CORSA could cover the liability on SeeMore. Ken will provide CORSA with the schedule if they need it. Decals are arriving for the trailer. A new spare tire for trailer is in order. Liability insurance for trailer and SeeMore still being researched. Shout out thank you to Erica Anderson for the information she provided from State Farm. More hands are needed to work on SeeMore.

Policies

Proposal to amend two paragraphs under PPCC Standing Rules and General Policies in the by-laws.

- 1. Add a paragraph D under Expenditures. Paragraph to read: The Board has defined the major expenditures dollar amount, for each occurrence, to be no more 5% of the current balance in the General Fund.
- 2. Amend paragraph C under Expenditures to include a sentence to read: Reimbursement for all expenses under this paragraph will be disbursed from the "SeeMore Fund," and not from the club's General Fund.

There was some discussion and clarifications made, example given that clarifies how the calculations are done. Both proposals to be amended were approved.

Mary Ellen mentioned to the group that the 2019 motion for the 50/50 raffle funds to benefit the SeeMore fund would have to be renewed for 2020.
