Need bid to CORSA ASAP with dates. Eric of RMC has the details of what needs to be done.

From those present there is interest, now that they have more information.

Another survey will go out with information on what help will be needed, and asking who would be interested in volunteering, as chairmen or as support staff.

PPCC board needs to propose to club membership if we should go forward and commit to the Convention.
