Prices all over the place for these, Clarks has a nice repro for \$32. eBay has them for as low as \$48, and then Mike's Corviar Parts (one of our vendors) has theirs posted for \$199.99 (come on man!). To be fair, they also have a repro posted for \$23.95. Well, this one on hand is nice, yours for \$25.





TURBO STUFF: 1965 Corvair Corsa Turbo-Charged Emblem – This is a nice example of the 1965 (one year only) turbo emblem which was on the CORSA engine lid. Clark's has discontinued their 2nds, tough to find in other places, if you're looking. I only saw one currently on eBay for \$59, and it's all scratched up, so when I post this one on eBay next week, I'll list it for \$999,999 and see where it lands. For you, the special Colorado Corvair Club Member price is \$60 (which is about what I paid for it a couple years ago on eBay ©





<u>TURBO STUFF:</u> '63-'66 Corvair Spyder/Corsa Turbo Manifold Gasket (x2) — This is the special gasket goes between the chrome intake and the head. Clark's Part # C12A, runs \$3.75 each. I have two on hand, FREE to a good home.



<u>TURBO STUFF:</u> '63-'66 Corvair Spyder/Corsa Turbo Gas Filter – This NOS AC GF-99 gas filter has threaded fittings and the fuel return nipple. These are a must if you're looking to put your turbo car in a concourse inspection which focuses on originality. Clark's black painted repro sells for \$36.70 (part # C8). These were pricey and hard to find even when I had my Spyder. \$40 and it's yours. And, a bonus!
