Standard Business:

Minutes of last meeting: Minutes from the March meeting were reviewed and approved. Rob caught that minutes showed a date in 2025, a real flashback.

Treasurer's Report: End of March balance was \$8,671.35. Treasurer's Report was approved.

Old Business:

- **Membership:** Thanks to Steve for a major effort to get renewals by calling. Several were planning to renew at the last meeting but didn't since we were not in person. Member count was 65 vs 67 on past roster. Public shaming began: Mario Wibbens, Kevin Shipman, and Joe Kennedy as not paid from past year. Rosters available from Rick. - School of Mines Car show will be on April 19 (Sunday). Meet at phone company building at to drive in together. Some years T-shirts, not this year.
- We continued the discussions for the Colorado Railroad museum event on Sunday April 26, 1-5. Meet at phone company building at ?? to drive in together. Cost is \$17 adult / \$15 seniors / \$7 children 2-18. Sign up online to buy tickets ahead. Park across from entrance, aux parking lot. John Dawson noted that the museum has expanded acreage, added crosswalk, parking across street. Discussed other train venues such as the Georgetown Loop. That one would require further advance planning and commitment to buy tickets together if we plan to ride the train. Rob suggested one train event for the year for now to avoid overload. John Dawson shared some Georgetown Loop history and talked about past events there.
- Tri-State date has been set for June 5 -7 in Montrose. Link on website to PPCC site. Call hotel directly. NO cutoff dates set yet. Car show will be in the afternoon due to conflict with another group for the park.

New Business:

- Discussion of new location, plans for next month. In favor of doing again? General acceptance. Possible northern location? Jaime's at 6th and Garrison. Steve noted that Jaime's could be noisy. Mike got a 2nd remote for the TV at Elway, now we don't need. Also we forgot to advise Elway Chevrolet that we wouldn't be there, will do so.
- CCCC report, rick, Forney Dust & Shine, (July 18) 8:30 be there to get instructions and start at 9. This is another data change. Supports the CCCC, as the Forney stores CCCC property on site at no charge. Also the club that was signed up for April is not able to go, so Rick is trying to put together a group from various clubs. Flyers were available for the July 25 big car show, proceeds funds lobbyist who represents collector car enthusiasts. Hand out flyers at car events. Electronic copy given to Dale. Volunteers are needed also at that show for parking, golf cart drivers moving people around, and directing people for 2 hr shift. Free entry and parking. CCCC VP Tom Mansfield wrote letter about show, but also asking member clubs to donate \$100 to cause. CCCC is now a 501c3 org. A swap meet table is \$60. Legislature is currently trying to fill \$1B shortfall, so no moves either way related to our hobby at this time. Eric, move to send \$100. Seconded, approved by vote. Bad news on state DMV, couldn't come up with cost 10k for programming change related to historic military vehicles. Bill was sponsored and cosponsored to fix, but couldn't pass due to funding shortfall. Died in appropriations committee.

- Facebook? John Dawson reported not much going on. Very little traffic.
- Tony talked about a car show at Rosie's Diner in Aurora next Friday.
- The Golden SuperCruise tonight is tonight, first Saturdays. Weathertech show is on 2nd Sundays, April 12 is the next.
