DIRECTIONS: 3640 Gaines Road, St. Augustine, Florida (doesn't hurt to check Map Quest)

From I 95:

Directions from I-95--- North or South. Get off at Exit 318 (Route 16). Head East about 3 miles. Take a left onto WOODLAWN ROAD. Go about 1.3 miles and take a left onto GAINES ROAD. This road will dead-end into the facility. Stay on the paved road (unless instructed otherwise) and you will arrive at site.
