Send your stories and photos for bragging rights

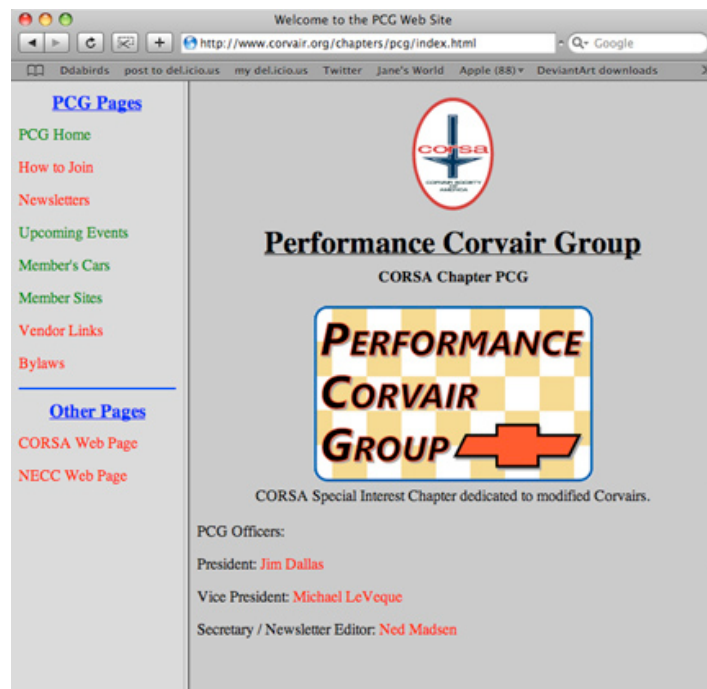
Performance Corvair Group has a new website: <http://www.corvair.org/chapters/pcg/index.html>
